4.0 TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER CENTER

We are one of the first and few Technological Transfer Centers - CTT 4.0 in Italy certified by Unioncamere according to the MISE directorial decree 22/12/2017. As CTT 4.0 we have developed a series of new technologies to support businesses.

4.0 TRAINING

PATENT BOX

We guide companies in the creation, development, maintenance and improvement of corporate intangible assets – such as industrial patents, designs and models, software covered by copyright - guaranteeing access to the preferential tax rate.



ERASMUS+

We participate in the drafting and implementation of EU funded projects and we are actively involved in various proposals in the framework of the seven-year 2021-2027, sharing innovation, technology transfer, R&D and teaching activities. The E+ Consortium was born from the collaboration of CRSL, University of Tuscia and Carolina Albasio High School, to support the mobility of students and professionals with vocational training opportunities in companies from foreign countries.

We represent a strategic partner of companies and public and private bodies for access to European funds from national (PON, POR, PSR, etc.) and international (Horizon 2020, Interreg, transnational cooperation, etc.) programs that require the presentation of complex and high-content projects scientific and technological.

RIPEC

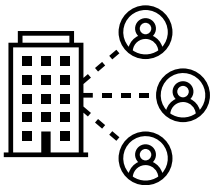

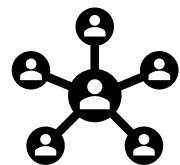
The partnership is composed of a French NGO, an Irish language school and an Italian university
