What is it?

A CV/e-portfolio repository



A digital database with precise characteristics:

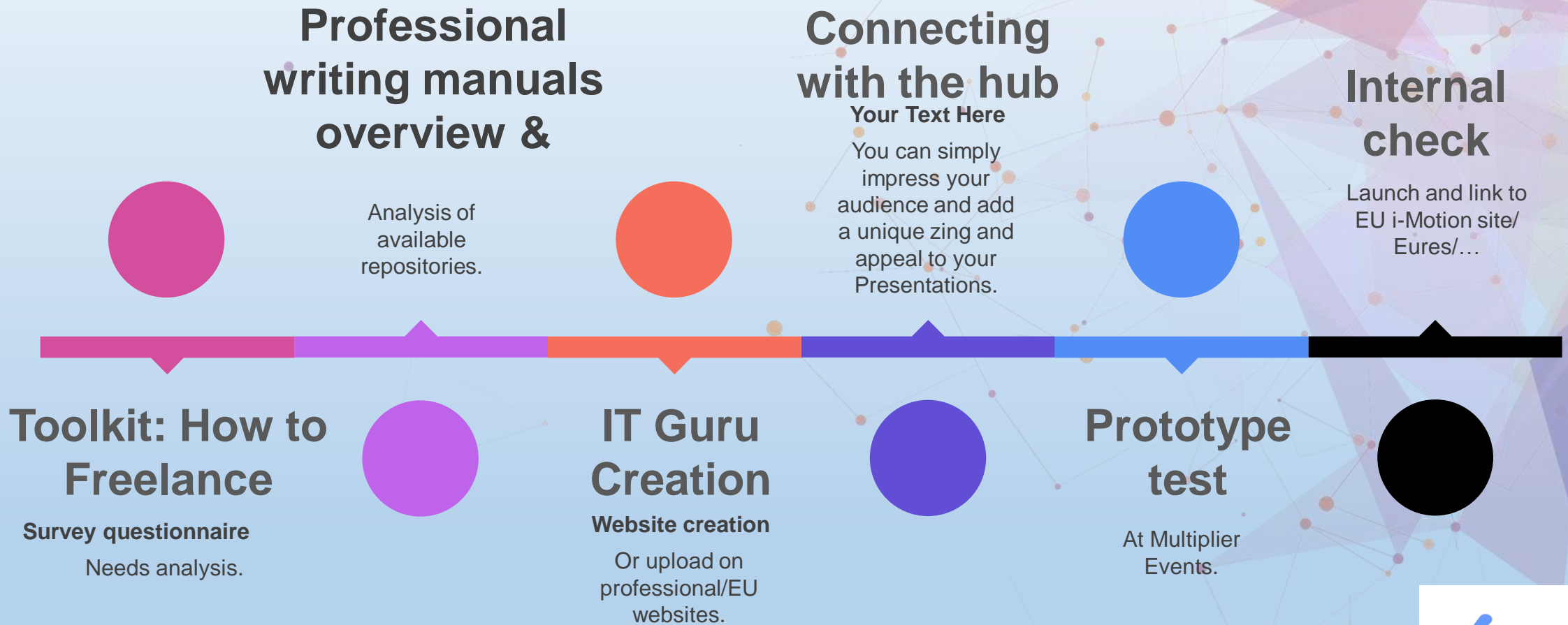
- content is deposited, whether by the content creator, owner or third party;
- the repository architecture manages content as well as metadata;
- the repository offers a minimum set of basic services e.g., put, get, search, access control; and
- the repository must be sustainable and trusted, well-supported and well-managed (Heery & Anderson 2005, p.6).

It is different from a mere collection:

- a) It allows data sharing, reuse, and preservation
- b) It has some form of indexing that makes similar to a digital library with some more benefits ↓
 - Integration into a website/platform
 - Possibilities to add plug-ins, blogs, links, etc...
 - Require decisions as to: number of files to upload, availability to download (speed, number of simultaneous access, safety protocol, etc...)

opportunities

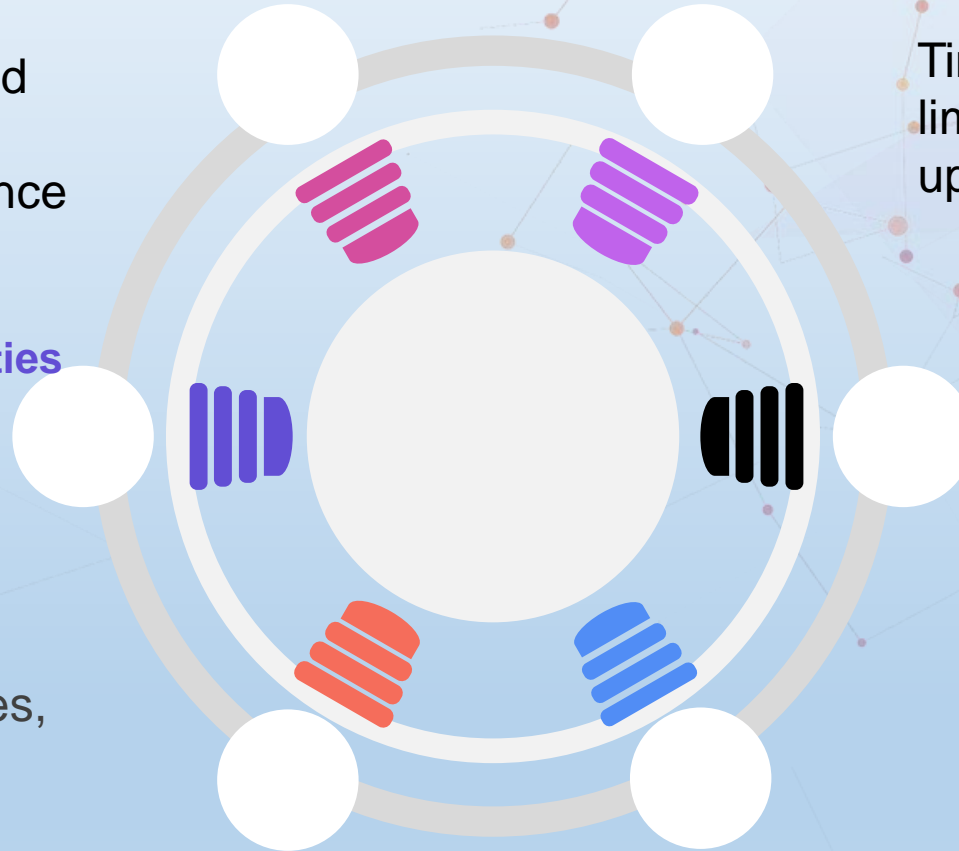

threats

There are already similar platforms, such as EURES, DigitalSkills-Job EU (with a good practice manual), which are larger and in use; There are multiple “digital job observatories”
